

**SPECIAL TOWN MEETING WARRANT
TOWN OF BUCKLAND,
COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS, FRANKLIN SS.**

To either of the Constables of the Town of Buckland in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn said inhabitants of said Town, qualified to vote in town affairs, to meet at the Mohawk Trail Regional High School at 6:30 PM on Wednesday, May 8, 2013, then and there to act on the following articles:

ARTICLE 1: To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer from available funds, or otherwise provide a sum of money to pay for the Buckland share of EMERGENCY WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY EXPENSES AND REPAIRS incurred as a result of Tropical Storm Irene, or take any action relating thereto.

ARTICLE 2: To see if the Town will vote to transfer funds from overlay surplus to cover a DEFICIT IN THE FISCAL YEAR 2009 OVERLAY, or take any action relating thereto.

ARTICLE 3: To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer from available funds, or otherwise provided a sum of money to pay for Fiscal Year 2013 WINTER ROADS EXPENSES, or take any action relating thereto.

You are directed to serve this warrant by posting attested copies thereof at the United States Post Office and Buckland Public Library, Buckland Center, and Town Hall, 17 State Street, in said town, fourteen days at least, before the time of holding said meeting.

Thereof fail not, and make due return of this warrant, with your doings thereon, to the Town Clerk, at the time and place of meeting as aforesaid. Given under our hand this 23rd day of April, in the year two thousand thirteen.
